## **1<sup>st</sup> Race: Stick Horse Race 1:00 PM**

Open to children who have not had their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. This race shall be run over approximately 6 yards on the flat. Catch weight. Open to all types of stick horses.

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Race: Lead Line Race 1:30 PM**

Open to children who have not had their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. Ponies must be lead by parent with child mounted. Parent will be disqualified if the pony canters.

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Race: Pony Field Masters Chase \* 2:00 PM**

Open to junior riders on ponies. Riders are to not have had their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. All ponies must be a minimum of 5 years old. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 2 miles with no more than 12 obstacles none of which are to exceed 2'3". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released.

## **4<sup>th</sup> Race: Junior Field Masters Chase \* 2:30 PM**

Open to junior riders on horses. Riders are to not have had their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. All horses must be a minimum of 5 years old. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 2 miles with no more than 12 obstacles none of which are to exceed 2'6". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released. Horse whips are forbidden.

## **5<sup>th</sup> Race: Senior Field Masters Chase \* 3:00 PM**

Open to amateurs who have never won a sanctioned race. All mounts are to be a minimum of 5 years old and are to not have won a sanctioned timber race in the last 3 years. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 3 miles with no more than 18 obstacles; jumps will be approximately 3'3". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Proper hunting attire preferred. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released. Horse whips are forbidden.

## **6<sup>th</sup> Race: Martha Sanders' Steeplethon \* 3:30 PM**

Open to amateur riders not to have won a sanctioned race in the last 5 years, excluding foxhunter races. Horses must be a minimum of 5 years old, have proof of being fairly hunted, and are not to have won a sanctioned timber race in the last 3 years, excluding foxhunter races. This race shall be run over approximately 3 miles of fair hunting country. The course will be flagged and contain no more than 18 obstacles, jumps will be approximately 3'3". Proper hunting or racing attire accepted. **This race is combined Novice Steeplethon and Owner/Rider Steeplethon. Race will be split based weight if entries allow.**

## **7<sup>th</sup> Race: Plantation Horse Race 4:00 PM**

½ mile on the flat. Horses must pace and plantation saddles and bridles must be worn. All horses and riders must be known to committee.

## **8<sup>th</sup> Race: Junior Foxhunter's Flat Race \* 4:30 PM**

Open to riders who have not reached their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the 1<sup>st</sup> current year. Catch weights. Open to fairly hunted horses. This course may be run over hunt country with the distance not to exceed 1 ½ miles.

## **9<sup>th</sup> Race: Senior Foxhunter's Flat Race \* 5:00 PM**

This race is open to amateur riders over the age of 16 on fairly hunted horses. This course will run over approximately 2 miles of hunting country. Horses must be a minimum of 5 years of age. Minimum weight of 165 lbs.
